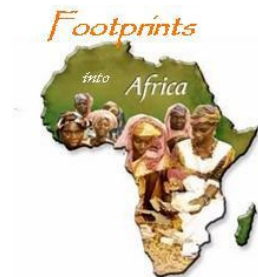
### 1. KWAZULU-NATAL MISSIONARY AND BIBLE COLLEGE
