My very dear friends,

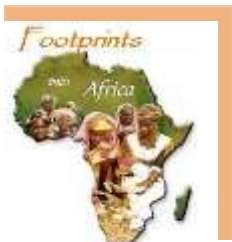

Pray that I will be able to get to all 4 of these countries next year.
