In a day when so many Colleges and Churches have lost the passion for MISSIONS, focusing on secondary issues, may we remain focused on the main thing.

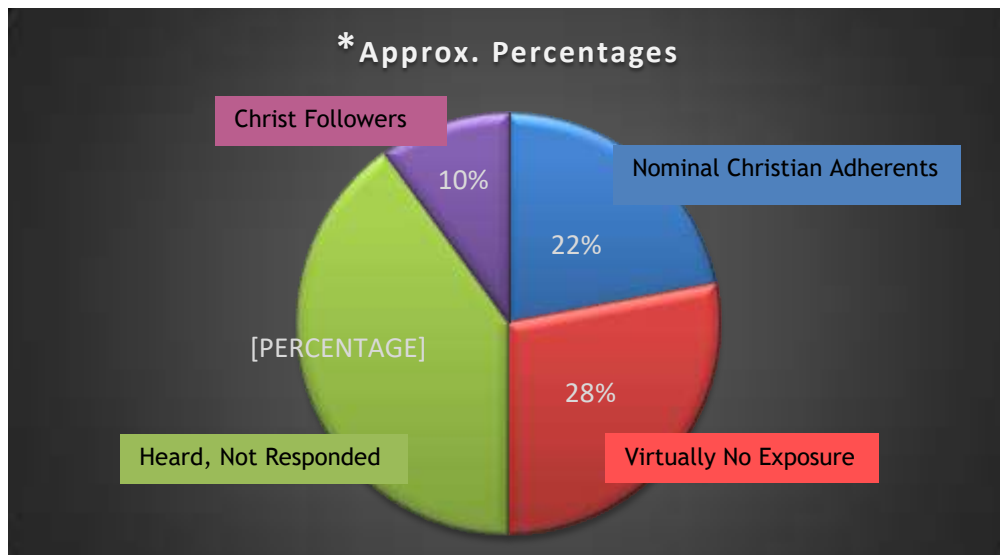

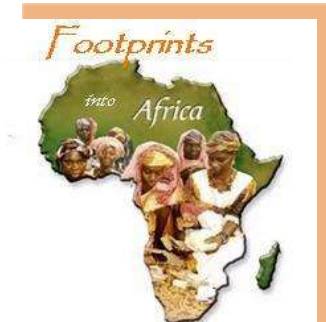
