“Global mission is the purpose for which we all have breath. Every Christian lives and dies for the spreading of God’s glory among all the nations.”



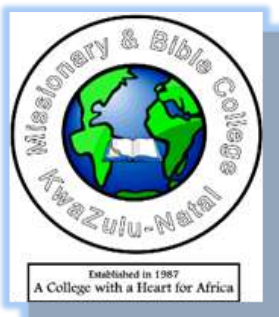
[Robert Savage](#) in the same article wrote:

So my life is so very full and focussed on Missions. As **David Brainerd** once wrote:

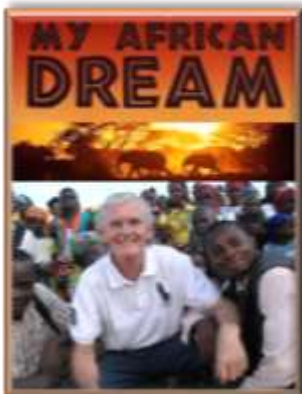


"I care not where or how I live, or what hardships I go through, so that I could but gain souls to Christ."
