EVENT 2 - ARCIT (Advanced Reading Course in Theology)

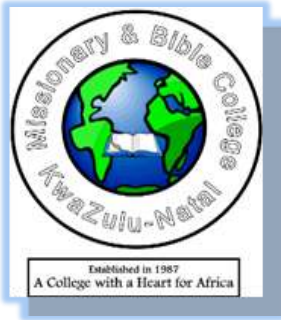
