It is now 37 years later since that time when I approached my amazing secretary, Brenda Dunn, affectionately known as Frances, and asked her if she would come with me and start a Bible College. We had no money, no buildings, no experience, just a heart to assist Africa in her greatest need – that is to train pastors and missionaries for Africa. And so, we opened our doors in 1987 with two students, one of whom was Lynne Cameron, and the Trinity Academy (now Kwazulu-Natal Missionary & Bible College) began.

It has been the most wonderful experience anyone could ever be blessed to have been given. Over 370 pastors and missionaries have been trained and sent all over Africa, even as far as Paraguay, Cambodia, Pakistan and Indonesia. Over the years I have received calls and been approached by churches in Canada, the USA, and was even offered the post as Principal of other colleges in South Africa. But, each time I have declined, believing God wanted me here in Africa and at KMBC. Now let me bring you up to date on my work:

With Covid we sadly had no 1st year students in 2021 when we were in lockdown, which meant that in 2022 we had no students to move up, and this year, 2023 we have no 3rd year students. Through all this we kept going and next year, 2024, we will be fully operational again with 1st, 2nd and 3rd year student classes, as well as our Missions stream.


