At the end of February the pot was empty and we could not pay our bills, but then I received a call from the firm handling the bequest from our dear brother, Sam Viljoen, and that the funds would be deposited into our account with 2 days. Wow ... that was perfect timing. KMBC is now covered for another few months. Our work continues, our precious students are provided for; and we give all the glory to the Lord. We have students in 5 of the 6 categories of study program. We are only missing our 3rd year stream, but next year we will have recovered from the Covid-19 setbacks, and will be running with our full curriculum.
