As you all know the past 3 years have not been easy years as we slowly recovered after Covid-19. But now in 2024 we will be able to again offer all our different courses which is wonderful, and by God's amazing grace, each one of needs has been met. So let me know share with you some of the highlights of my work, which I pray will be a huge encouragement to you, to see how your prayers have been answered and where your money has been spent.



KWAZULU-NATAL MISSIONARY AND BIBLE COLLEGE

When we launched our DIPLOMA IN MISSIONS program 12 years ago (the students come for two sessions of 90-days each, plus homework) little did we realize that this would become, under the sovereignty of God, our main course. This last term of 2023, for example saw 12 mission students coming to us from across Africa. At the end of this year, we will have 7 graduating with their Diploma in Missions, which is a great thrill for us. 4 years have now

seen us through the Covid debacle, and we are again able to offer our 3-year Diploma in Pastoral Theology.

This term we also launched our *ADVANCED COURSE IN MISSIONAL DEVELOPMENT* (30-DAY COURSE), and certainly look forward to this also taking off - we have received 8 applications already for January.

Then next month at our graduation we will have the first graduate of our ADVANCED READING COURSE IN THEOLOGY, which Margaret Thompson has now completed. It will also be a great joy to see one of the Distance Learners graduating with his 1-year Diploma in Ministry and three with their 2-year Diploma in Theology.

Our dream, as you all know, is to train pastors and missionaries for Africa, and at the graduation service on 9th December, it is very humbling to realize that over these past 37 years, nearly 400 students have been passed through my college and gone into Africa, and abroad.

Thank you for your amazing support ... be greatly encouraged. For those able to attend, these are the details of our graduation.


