Register at the Campus of:
KwaZulu-Natal Missionary and Bible College

Candidates must come to South Africa for 2 sessions of 90-days each.

Each 90-day course is made up of:

- Bible training
- Missions assignments
- Missions Tutorial & Video Sessions
- Assessments

Subjects covered will include:

- Bible Books
- Practical Christian Living
- Christianity in the World
- Surveys
- Ministry Skills
- Systematic Theology
- Missions

After the 90-day study course is completed, candidates will return home to implement and mobilize their Churches and leaders for MISSIONS.

Homework will be given, that will need to be completed before returning for the second session of 90-days.

The course is made up of two sessions of 90-day visit to South Africa.

The College academic year is divided into the four periods:

Every candidates must to attend 2 (two) sessions of 90-days to complete, and to qualify for, the Missions Diploma

The 90-day periods of choice are:

January - March

April - June

July - September

October - November

Upon completion of the programme, the graduation service should ideally take place in candidate's home church or at the Footprints. The Graduation here in South Africa takes place each year during the first week in December.

ADMISSION POLICY FOR DIPLOMA IN MISSIONS

WHAT YOU NEED TO COVER

1. Availability to travel to South Africa for two visits of 90-days each
2. Valid Passport, with Yellow Fever stamp
3. 90-day Visitor's Permit.
4. **Return Travel bookings to travel to Johannesburg and another journey through to Pietermaritzburg, which is a 6/8 hours journey.**
5. Own food for Saturdays and Sundays
6. General support for airtime, personal items, and pens pencils and books to take notes.

2. Accommodation plus (one) 1 meal per day, Monday through Friday.
