Let me bring you up to date on my work in Africa. I hope it encourages you, my faithful supporters.




### KWAZULU-NATAL MISSIONARY & BIBLE COLLEGE


“again, and again the longing comes over me to get back to Africa.”

- My next visit is up to Mozambique; then on to Malawi, and then Rwanda, completing 81 trips into MAMA AFRICA.




## PREACHING

## **BUT**


