I have just finished reading "THE PACKER COLLECTION" edited by A. Mc Grath. It was a wonderful read and here is an example for you to ponder:

In our work of evangelism, Christians are sent to convert, and they should not allow themselves, as Christ's representatives in the world, to aim at anything less. Evangelizing, therefore, is not simply a matter of teaching, and instructing, and imparting information to the mind. There is more to it than that. Evangelizing includes the endeavor to elicit a response to the truth taught. It is communication with a view to conversion. It is a matter not merely of informing, but also of inviting. It is an attempt to *gain* (KJV), or *win*, or *catch* our fellow men for Christ (1 Corinthians 9:19-23; 1 Peter 3:1; Luke 5:10. Our Lord depicts it as fisherman's work (Matthew 4:19; 13:47).

This shows why thoughtful Christians have always seen missionary ministry as the church's top priority in this world. Since it is only as individuals become Christians that the ruins of their lives get rebuilt, evangelism is service of each person's deepest need, and is thus the truest love of one's neighbour."


What a reminder that "missionary ministry" is the Church's top priority in the world ... and the truest love of one's neighbour". Here is the update on my work for your interest and prayer.


term.


Please make an extra effort to be at our closing MMM, focusing on another of God's great Generals. It will be a wonderful wrap up for a brilliant year!




