Who would ever have thought that in 1986 when Bishop Bradley sent me up to Ovamboland to conduct a Bible School for our Churches, it would lead me to where I am today. That trip planted a seed in my heart that has now grown over 40 years into my dream. The dream was to train pastors and missionaries for Africa and has driven me to give my life to this work, knowing that 85% of all pastors in Africa had no Bible Training. By the grace of God alone, in spite of having no lovely buildings or money, my college has now sent out over 414 trained pastors and missionaries right across Africa - to **Morocco, Uganda, Tanzania, Kenya, Rwanda, Burundi, Mozambique, Malawi, Zimbabwe, Zambia, Ghana, Madagascar, Botswana, Democratic Republic of Congo, Namibia** and right across South Africa. Some students have even gone to England, New Zealand, Australia, Paraguay, Cambodia, Pakistan and Indonesia. **Wow ... the miracle of the grace of God.**

Last year ended on a wonderful note with our graduation where another 11 trained pastors and missionaries were sent out across South Africa, even up to Tanzania and Kenya.




Phew ... if all this can be fitted in, it will be amazing, but glorious for me. Please pray for strength and wonderful times of renewal with my students.



7. For new opportunities for me to share the Word of God in and around our Province



