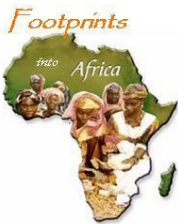

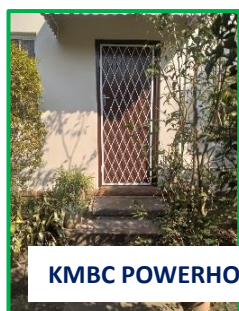

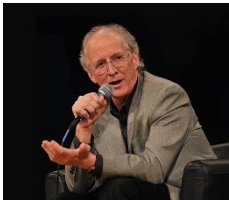

From Piper:

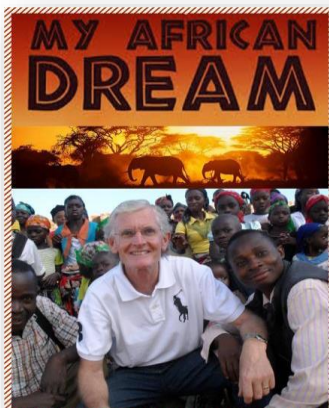
Let us continue to pray as we did at our MMM, for our continent of Africa:
